Reliability

The Mean Time Between Failure (MTBF) is calculated at full output power and an operating ambient temperature (T_A) of +40°C, which is a typical condition in Information and Communication Technology (ICT) equipment. Different methods could be used to calculate the predicted MTBF and failure rate which may give different results. Ericsson Power Modules currently uses one method, Telcordia SR332.

Predicted MTBF for the series is:

7.2 million hours according to Telcordia SR332, issue
 1, Black box technique.

Telcordia SR332 is a commonly used standard method intended for reliability calculations in ICT equipment. The parts count procedure used in this method was originally modelled on the methods from MIL-HDBK-217F, Reliability Predictions of Electronic Equipment. It assumes that no reliability data is available on the actual units and devices for which the predictions are to be made, i.e. all predictions are based on generic reliability parameters.

Compatibility with RoHS requirements

The products are compatible with the relevant clauses and requirements of the RoHS directive 2002/95/EC and have a maximum concentration value of 0.1% by weight in homogeneous materials for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, PBB and PBDE and of 0.01% by weight in homogeneous materials for cadmium.

Exemptions in the RoHS directive utilized in Ericsson Power Modules products include:

- Lead in high melting temperature type solder (used to solder the die in semiconductor packages)
- Lead in glass of electronics components and in electronic ceramic parts (e.g. fill material in chip resistors)
- Lead as an alloying element in copper alloy containing up to 4% lead by weight (used in connection pins made of Brass)

Quality Statement

The products are designed and manufactured in an industrial environment where quality systems and methods like ISO 9000, 6 σ (sigma), and SPC are intensively in use to boost the continuous improvements strategy. Infant mortality or early failures in the products are screened out and they are subjected to an ATE-based final test. Conservative design rules, design reviews and product qualifications, plus the high competence of an engaged work force, contribute to the high quality of our products.

General information

Ericsson Power Modules DC/DC converters and DC/DC regulators are designed in accordance with safety standards IEC/EN/UL60950, *Safety of Information Technology Equipment*.

IEC/EN/UL60950 contains requirements to prevent injury or damage due to the following hazards:

- Electrical shock
- Energy hazards
- Fire
- Mechanical and heat hazards
- Radiation hazards
- Chemical hazards

On-board DC-DC converters are defined as component power supplies. As components they cannot fully comply with the provisions of any Safety requirements without "Conditions of Acceptability". It is the responsibility of the installer to ensure that the final product housing these components complies with the requirements of all applicable Safety standards and Directives for the final product.

Component power supplies for general use should comply with the requirements in IEC60950, EN60950 and UL60950 "Safety of information technology equipment".

There are other more product related standards, e.g. IEEE802.3af "Ethernet LAN/MAN Data terminal equipment power", and ETS300132-2 "Power supply interface at the input to telecommunications equipment; part 2: DC", but all of these standards are based on IEC/EN/UL60950 with regards to safety.

Ericsson Power Modules DC/DC converters and DC/DC regulators are UL60950 recognized and certified in accordance with EN60950.

The flammability rating for all construction parts of the products meets requirements for V-0 class material according to IEC 60695-11-10.

The products should be installed in the end-use equipment, in accordance with the requirements of the ultimate application. Normally the output of the DC/DC converter is considered as SELV (Safety Extra Low Voltage) and the input source must be isolated by minimum Double or Reinforced Insulation from the primary circuit (AC mains) in accordance with IEC/EN/UL60950.

Isolated DC/DC converters

It is recommended that a slow blow fuse with a rating twice the maximum input current per selected product be used at the input of each DC/DC converter. If an input filter is used in the circuit the fuse should be placed in front of the input filter.

In the rare event of a component problem in the input filter or in the DC/DC converter that imposes a short circuit on the input source, this fuse will provide the following functions:

- Isolate the faulty DC/DC converter from the input power source so as not to affect the operation of other parts of the system.
- Protect the distribution wiring from excessive current and power loss thus preventing hazardous overheating.

The galvanic isolation is verified in an electric strength test. The test voltage ($V_{\rm iso}$) between input and output is 1500 Vdc or 2250 Vdc for 60 seconds (refer to product specification).

Leakage current is less than 1 µA at nominal input voltage.

24 V DC systems

The input voltage to the DC/DC converter is SELV (Safety Extra Low Voltage) and the output remains SELV under normal and abnormal operating conditions.

48 and 60 V DC systems

If the input voltage to Ericsson Power Modules DC/DC converter is 75 Vdc or less, then the output remains SELV (Safety Extra Low Voltage) under normal and abnormal operating conditions.

Single fault testing in the input power supply circuit should be performed with the DC/DC converter connected to demonstrate that the input voltage does not exceed 75 Vdc.

If the input power source circuit is a DC power system, the source may be treated as a TNV2 circuit and testing has demonstrated compliance with SELV limits and isolation requirements equivalent to Basic Insulation in accordance with IEC/EN/UL60950.

Non-isolated DC/DC regulators

The input voltage to the DC/DC regulator is SELV (Safety Extra Low Voltage) and the output remains SELV under normal and abnormal operating conditions.













Top trace: output voltage (5 V/div.). Bottom trace: input voltage (20 V/div.). Time scale: 2 ms/div.














The radiated EMI performance of the DC/DC converter will depend on the PCB layout and ground layer design. It is also important to consider the stand-off of the DC/DC converter.

If a ground layer is used, it should be connected to the output of the DC/DC converter and the equipment ground or chassis.

A ground layer will increase the stray capacitance in the PCB and improve the high frequency EMC performance.


Input Voltage

The input voltage range 38...72Vdc meets the requirements of the European Telecom Standard ETS 300 132-2 for normal input voltage range in –48 and –60 Vdc systems, –40.5...-57.0 V and –50.0...-72 V respectively. At input voltages exceeding 72 V, the power loss will be higher than at normal input voltage and T_{ref} must be limited to absolute max +85°C. The absolute maximum continuous input voltage is 75Vdc.

Turn-off Input Voltage

The PKR 4000 Series DC/DC converters monitor the input voltage and will turn on and turn off at predetermined levels. The minimum hysteresis between turn on and turn off input voltage is 1V.

Remote Control (RC)



The products are fitted with a remote control function referenced to the primary negative input connection (- In), with positive logic. The RC function allows the converter to be turned on/off by an external device like a semiconductor or mechanical switch. The RC pin has an internal pull up resistor to + In.

The maximum required sink current is 0.1 mA. When the RC pin is left open, the voltage generated on the RC pin is <15 V. To ensure that the converter stays off the voltage must be below 1.0V.

Input voltage adjust

The converter has an under voltage monitor which make the converter turn-on and turn-off at predetermined input voltages level. These levels can be adjusted upwards or downwards by means of external resistors. To increase the voltage level, a resistor is connected between pin 11 and 17. The resistance value is given by the equation:





Output Voltage Adjust (Vadj)

All PKR 4000 Series DC/DC converters have an Output Voltage Adjust pin (V_{adj}). This pin can be used to adjust the output voltage above or below output voltage initial setting. At increased output voltages the maximum power rating of the converter remains the same, and the max output current must be decreased correspondingly.

The output voltage can be increased or decreased by means of external resistors or other external circuitry. If other circuitry is used, the slew rate has to be limited to maximum 5 V/ms. To increase the voltage a resistor should be connected between the V_{adj} pin and +IN. To decrease the output voltage, a resistor is connected between V_{adj} pin and NOR pin. The resistor value of the Output voltage adjust function is according to information given under the Output section for the respective product.







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Operating information, cont.

Input And Output Impedance

The impedance of both the input source and the load will interact with the impedance of the DC/DC converter. It is important that the input source has low characteristic impedance. The PKR 4000 Series DC/DC converters are designed for stable operation without external capacitors connected to the input or output. The performance in some applications can be enhanced by addition of external capacitance as described under maximum capacitive load. If the input voltage source contains significant inductance, the addition of a 10 μ F capacitor across the input of the converter will ensure stable operation. The capacitor is not required when powering the DC/DC converter from an input source with an inductance below 10 μ H.

Maximum Capacitive Load

When powering loads with significant dynamic current requirements, the voltage regulation at the load can be improved by addition of decoupling capacitors at the load. The most effective technique is to locate low ESR ceramic capacitors as close to the load as possible, using several capacitors to lower the effective ESR. The ceramic capacitors will handle high-frequency dynamic load changes while electrolytic capacitors should be used to handle low frequency dynamic load changes.

It is equally important to use low resistance and low inductance PCB layouts and cabling.

External decoupling capacitors will become part of the control loop of the DC/DC converter and may affect the stability margins. As a "rule of thumb", 100 μ F/A of output current can be added without any additional analysis. The absolute maximum value of output capacitance is 5 000 μ F. For further information please contact your local Ericsson Power Modules representative.

Parallel Operation

Paralleling of several PKR 4000 converters is easily accomplished by direct connection of the output voltage terminal pins. The load regulation characteristic is specifically designed for optimal paralleling performance. Load sharing between converters will be within $\pm 10\%$. It is recommended not to exceed P_{O} = n x 0.9 x P_{Omax} , where P_{Omax} is the maximum converter output power and n the number of paralleled converters, to prevent overloading any of the converters and thereby decreasing the reliability performance.

Over Current Protection (OCP)

The PKR 4000 Series DC/DC converters include current limiting circuitry for protection at continuous overload. The output voltage will decrease towards zero for output currents in excess of max output current (max I_0). The converter will resume normal operation after removal of the overload. The load distribution should be designed for the maximum output short circuit current specified.



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Thermal Consideration

General

The PKR 4000 series DC/DC converters are designed to operate in different thermal environments and sufficient cooling must be provided to ensure reliable operation. Cooling is achieved mainly by conduction, from the pins to the PCB board, and convection, which is dependant on the airflow across the converter. Increased airflow enhances the cooling of the converter.


The Output Current Derating graph found in the Output section for each model provides the available output current vs. ambient air temperature and air velocity at $V_{in} = 53V$.

The DC/DC converter is tested on a 254 x 254 mm, 35 μ m (1 oz), 8-layer test board mounted vertically in a wind tunnel with a cross-section of 305 x 305 mm.

Proper cooling of the DC/DC converter can be verified by measuring the temperature at positions P1. The temperature at this position should not exceed the max values provided in the table below.

Note that the max value is the absolute maximum rating (non destruction) and that the electrical Output data is guaranteed up to $T_{\rm ref}$ +85°C.

Ambient Temperature Calculation

By using the thermal resistance the maximum allowed ambient temperature can be calculated.

- 1. The power loss is calculated by using the formula $((1/\eta) 1) \times$ output power = power losses (Pd). η = efficiency of converter. E.g 85 % = 0.85
- 2. Find the thermal resistance (Rth) in the Thermal Resistance graph found in the Output section for each model. Calculate the temperature increase (ΔT). ΔT = Rth x Pd
- 3. Max allowed ambient temperature is: Max Tref Λ T.

E.g PKR 4713 SI at 1m/s:

3. 110 °C - 17.3°C = max ambient temperature is 92.7°C

The actual temperature will be dependent on several factors such as the PCB size, number of layers and direction of airflow.







FOOTPRINT (top view, application board)




Detail Bottom side solder bumps





The recommended footprint (see previous page) is optimised for the solder bump design. However, the standard PKF footprint will also accommodate this solder bump design. The only differences is the solder pad width (2.8 versus 2.3 mm) and the c-c distance between the two rows of connectors (26.8 versus 26.6 mm).

The absolute and recommended keep out areas are not affected by the differences in application board footprint.




Illustration of a recommended design for a hot air repair nozzle for manual removal and re-mounting






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Soldering Information - Surface Mounting


The surface mount version of the product is intended for convection or vapor phase reflow in SnPb and Pb-free processes. To achieve a good and reliable soldering result, make sure to follow the recommendations from the solder paste supplier, to use state-of-the-art reflow equipment and reflow profiling techniques as well as the following guidelines.

When using and Sn/Pb solder in the host board assembly process, the composition of the mix of Pb- and Pb-free solder results in a higher melting temperature compared to standard Pb solder.

A no-clean flux is recommended to avoid entrapment of cleaning fluids in cavities inside the product or between the product and the host board. The cleaning residues may affect long time reliability and isolation voltage.

Minimum Pin Temperature Recommendations

Pin number 5 and 14 are chosen as reference locations for the minimum pin temperature recommendations since these will likely be the coolest solder joints during reflow.



SnPb solder processes

For Pb solder processes, a pin temperature (T_{PIN}) in excess of the solder melting temperature, (T_{L} , +183°C for Sn63/Pb37) for more than 30 seconds, and a peak temperature of +210°C is recommended to ensure a reliable solder joint.

Lead-free (Pb-free) solder processes

For Pb-free solder processes, a pin temperature (T_{PIN}) in excess of the solder melting temperature (T_{L} , +217 to +221 °C for Sn/Ag/Cu solder alloys) for more than 30 seconds, and a peak temperature of +235°C on all solder joints is recommended to ensure a reliable solder joint.

Peak Product Temperature Requirements

The main transformer is chosen as reference location for the maximum (peak) allowed product temperature (T_p) , since this will likely be the warmest part of the product during the reflow process.

To avoid damage or performance degradation of the product, the reflow profile should be optimized to avoid excessive heating. A sufficiently extended preheat time is recommended to ensure an even temperature across the host PCB, for both small and large devices. To reduce the risk of excessive heating is also recommended to reduce the time in the reflow zone as much as possible.

SnPb solder processes

For conventional SnPb solder processes, the product is qualified for MSL 1 according to IPC/JEDEC standard J-STD-020C.


During reflow, T_P must not exceed +225 °C at any time.

Lead-free (Pb-free) solder processes

For Pb-free solder processes, the product is qualified for MSL 3 according to IPC/JEDEC standard J-STD-020C.

During reflow, T_P must not exceed +260 °C at any time.





Dry Pack Information

The surface mount version of the product is delivered in trays or tape & reel. These inner shipment containers are dry packed in standard moisture barrier bags according to IPC/JEDEC standard J-STD-033 (Handling, packing, shipping and use of moisture/reflow sensitivity surface mount devices).




